Nicholas Graves, 2006 Claude Rosenberg Jr. Award

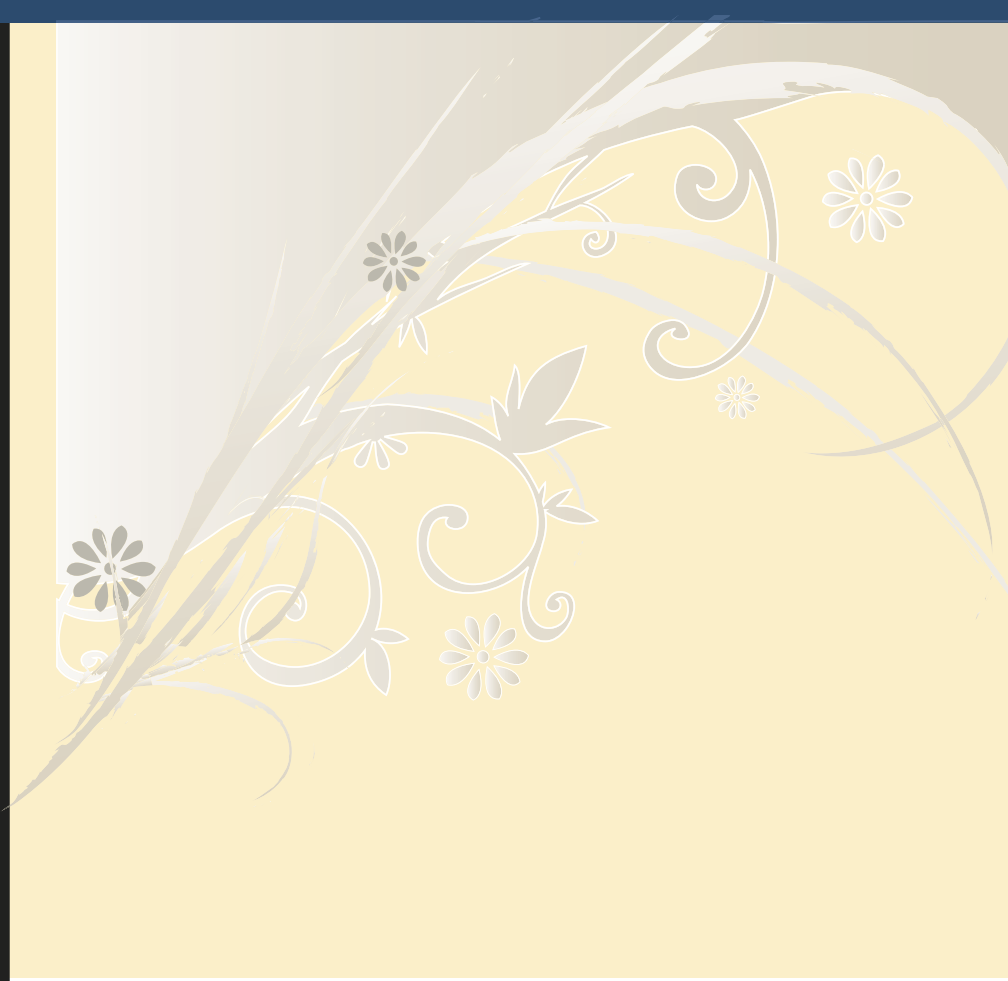
